Report on 2009 Vermont Tax Amnesty

The Vermont Tax Amnesty program as prescribed by 2009 (Special Session), Section H.3 was conducted from July 20 through August 31, 2009.

Selection of Accounts

The Department determined potentially eligible taxpayers by reviewing the June 30, 2009 accounts receivable and selecting all taxpayers with a tax liability for which the due date of the return was prior to January 26, 2009. Letters were sent to potentially eligible taxpayers. All tax types administered by the department were eligible.

Publicity

The Department contracted with Spike Advertising of Vermont for radio advertising, newspaper advertising and a follow-up mailing to eligible taxpayers. The Department worked with Spike to develop a website and detailed instructions for taxpayers. These steps assisted with our outreach to taxpayers who had delinquent tax obligations that the Department had not yet identified.
